The information presented in this newsletter gathers the response of 16 organizations representing 1,004 centers where aid is distributed or humanitarian projects are carried out.



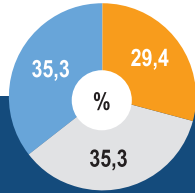
INCREASE IN UNMET HUMANITARIAN NEEDS

In the last year, which groups of people have observed an increase in unmet humanitarian needs?

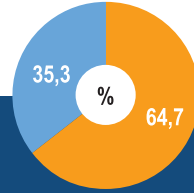


SUPPLIES FOR THE RESPONSE

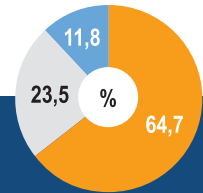
In the last six months, has your inventory of supplies been sufficient for the humanitarian assistance you provide?



Have you had access to fuel on a regular basis for activities requiring transportation?



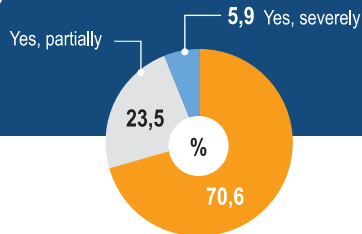
Have you regularly had safe passage or permits for the movement of personnel to the place of work or areas of humanitarian activity?



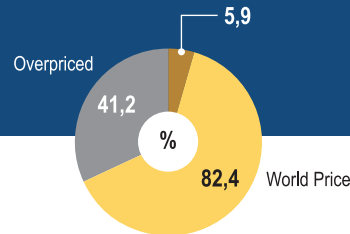

In the last six months, has your organization been forced to suspend operations?

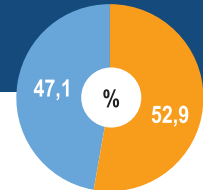


The price of fuel to which you usually have access to is:

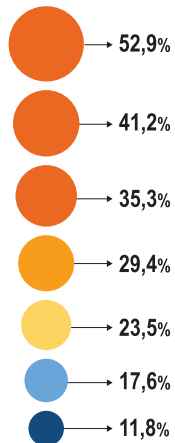


SAFETY

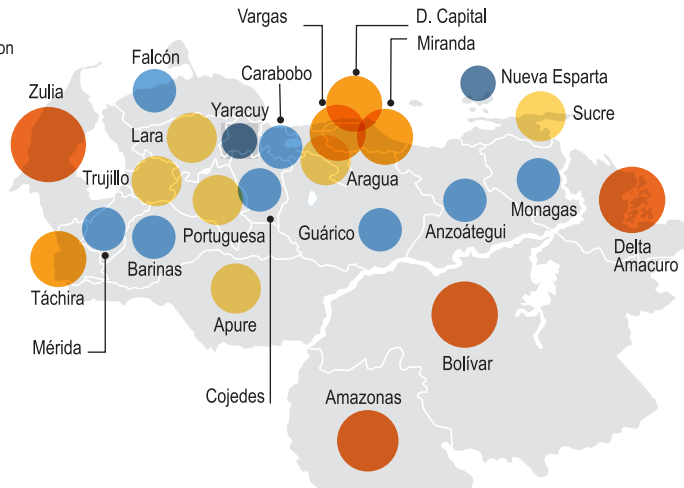
Have there been any incidents that put the safety of staff or beneficiaries at risk?

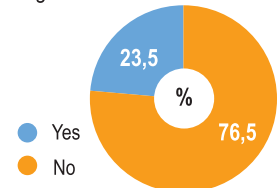


An open-ended question was used where more than one option could be chosen



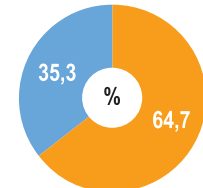
COMMUNITY ACCOUNTABILITY

Have there been any complaints from the communities about expectations of assistance not met by your organization?



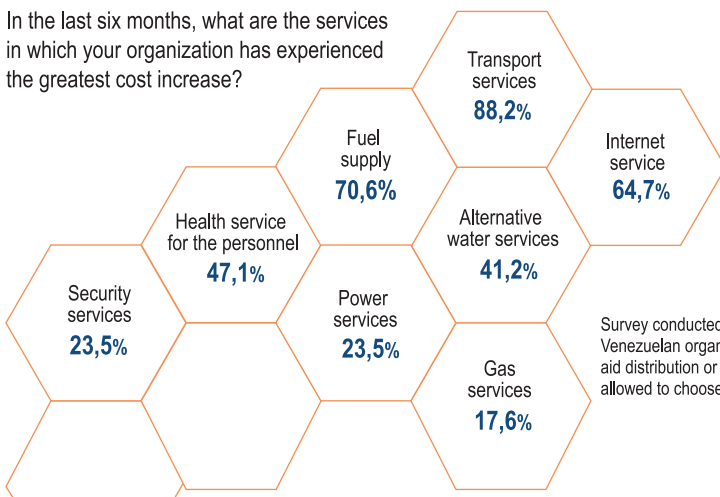
COORDINATION

In recent months, have you implemented partnerships with other organizations to mitigate operational barriers?



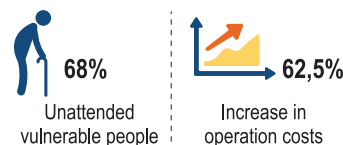
INCREASE IN OPERATING COSTS

Survey conducted between November and December 2021. Sixteen Venezuelan organizations participated, with humanitarian work in 1,044 aid distribution or project execution centers. The questions on the survey allowed to choose more than one option in some questions.
